本講の目的は、現代日本という素材が、政治学という比較政治および政治経済の諸議論の理解の深化にどのような貢献をもたらすかを考えることにある。特に、通常「経済の国際化」と「冷戦の終焉」と称される、国際政治と国際経済の変動が、各国の国内政策および対外政策をどう変化させ、その結果、どのような国内政治変動と国際的政策レジームを形成させるかを考察する
